

Park Use Policies for Groups Feeney Park

Posted Rules

All park users must obey all posted rules on site. Group organizers must ensure that everyone associated with the group obeys the rules, including spectators and siblings. Youth Sports Leagues. Organized youth sports leagues will have access to the Feeney Park facilities at an annual charge of \$7 per registered player for practice and regular season play. A use application must be approved in advance by the individual designated annually by the Feeney Park Foundation board of directors to run the park (“the Manager”), and all other park requirements must be met. Charges will be levied for tournament use if the teams participating in the tournament pay an entry fee. Charges will not be levied for all-star games or year-end championship tournaments.

Adult Sports Leagues

Adult sports leagues will be charged for use of the Feeney Park facilities at a rate set annually by the board. An adult sports activity will be considered part of a league when uniforms are worn, paid referees are used, and/or games are played on a regular schedule. Any organized adult activities must schedule use of the fields with the Manager, have a valid contract for use of the park, and meet all other park use requirements.

Special Events

Groups wishing to use Feeney Park will be charged for use according to a fee schedule drawn up annually, or on an event-specific basis. Organized special events must be authorized in advance by the Manager and must meet all requirements for park use. Set-up of tents, awnings, tables, or other structures must be approved in advance.

Scheduling

No organized group use of the park (advertised activities, any use involving money, leagues, commercial use, organized extended family gatherings, etc.) can be made without prior clearance from the Manager. Casual use by families or individuals, and informal group activities not involving money, uniforms, or referees is permitted at any time the facilities are available. Casual users must always defer to previously scheduled group activities. Information on scheduled activities is posted on the restroom message board.

Insurance and Indemnification

Any special event, youth or adult sports league, or other organized use of the park must show evidence of insurance specifically naming Feeney Park as an insured venue prior to use of the park, and have signed indemnification forms on file with the Manager.

Smoking and Alcohol

Use of tobacco products or alcoholic beverages at the park are prohibited except by special agreement.

FEES FOR 2011-2012 FEENEY PARK

Field Use

1) The following charges are for use of the upper or lower field area for organized adult sports activities as defined in Park Use Policies for Groups, and for selected other non-commercial group uses.

Upper or lower field, per game \$25, 2½ hour maximum

Upper or lower field, half-day \$50, up to 6 hours

Upper or lower field, full day \$80, daylight hours

2) Any events, tournaments, craft fairs, or other activities charging entry, participation, or any other fees will be charged by the Manager for park use on a case-by-case basis. Security deposits may be required.

3) At the option of the Manager, some groups may be allowed to work off fees by completing projects at the Park.

Snack Bar

Any group other than youth sports leagues wishing to make use of the Snack Bar will be charged as follows:

Half-day (up to 5 hours) \$100

Full day \$200

Community nonprofit organizations receive a 25% discount.

No alcoholic beverages may be sold except by prior agreement.

Advertisements

Professionally made plastic-coated plywood signs with logo and lettering can be permanently displayed along the lower field fences. Placement will be first come, first served starting near the maintenance building and working around to the Highway 4 side. Non-profit organizations will receive a 25% discount.
